# **R**equest for **A**cademic **C**onsiderations (RAC) for Extenuating Circumstances, 2023-24



# *Up to 3 consecutive days absence*

Students can submit one (1) Request for Academic Consideration per term without documentation\*

If you have documentation you are encouraged to submit it

### More than 3 days <u>or</u> subsequent submissions

- Submissions that span longer than 3 consecutive days or are subsequent submissions (within the same term) require documentation\*\*
- All missed final exams require documentation and an Incomplete Grade Request form must be submitted

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Documentation is required for absences of any length during final exams
- Note that absences for *bereavement* require documentation.

#### STEPS TO SUBMIT A RAC

- 1. Complete the student form found here https://gfeas.it/accom
- If applicable, collect supporting documentation. Save as pdf to submit in FEAS portal.
- > Students are required to submit requests within 7 days of their first day of absence. If unable to submit during that time, email the Program Advisor (Accommodations & Considerations) <a href="mailto:engineering.aac@queensu.ca">engineering.aac@queensu.ca</a> to ask for an extension to submit.
  - The Program Advisor will review the request and when processed, will notify the instructor(s). The student will be copied on the distribution email.
  - It is the students' responsibility to contact their instructor(s) to make arrangements on missed coursework. Please consult your course syllabus for more information on policies for missed coursework.
